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
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ABOUT US

SSG Parker Gordon Fox Suicide Prevention Program

The Staff Sergeant Parker Gordon Fox Suicide Prevention Grant Program (SSG Fox SPGP) enables VA to provide resources toward community-based suicide prevention efforts to meet the needs of Veterans and their families through outreach, suicide prevention services, and connection to VA and community resources.

SSG Fox SPGP honors Veteran Parker Gordon Fox, who joined the Army in 2014 and was a sniper instructor at the U.S. Army Infantry School at Fort Benning, Georgia. Known for a life of generosity and kindness to others in need, Fox died by suicide on July 21, 2020, at the age of 25.

SAAHEC is a grant recipient and its program provides resources toward community-based suicide prevention efforts to meet the needs of Veterans and their families through outreach, suicide prevention services, and connection to VA and community resources. SAAHEC's SSG Fox SAV project provides the following services:

- Outreach
- Baseline mental health screening
- Education on suicide risk and prevention
- VA benefits assistance for eligible
- Assistance with obtaining and coordinating other benefits
- Other services necessary for improving the mental health status and well-being and reducing the suicide risk of eligible individuals and their families

SART PROGRAMS

The South Alabama Rural Training (SART) program, funded by HRSA and the Delta Region Authority, aims to address the ongoing needs in healthcare facilities for trained administrative support professionals and clinical professionals in rural communities of the Alabama Delta Region.

It provides training and pathways to professional certifications and degrees to applicants in Butler, Conecuh, Escambia, Monroe and Clarke Counties. Scholarships will be offered to cover full tuition, fees, books, etc.
